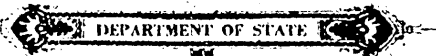

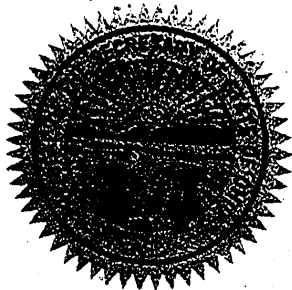

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

VICTORIAN VILLAGE SOCIETY

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq., Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be Victorian Village Society.

SECOND. The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is the City of Columbus, Franklin County.

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

a. To promote a spirit of neighborliness among residents of, and businesses and organizations within, the Victorian Village area.

b. To promote the restoration, preservation, and maintenance of the Historical District known as Victorian Village.

c. To promote the upgrading of business and professions in the area and encourage the development of new businesses in the area in keeping with the purposes of the Society.

d. To study the Social, and Civic needs of Victorian Village and to promote a program designed to strengthen the general welfare and unity of the area.

FOURTH. The number of initial trustees of this corporation shall be three (3) and shall serve said corporation as trustees

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until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect trustees.



FIFTH. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities to the corporation,

dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
