



*Dear Short North Community Organization,*

Over the last year, we have been working to institute a major change in our grant-making process which necessitated our taking a hiatus.

Based on the wishes of our primary donor to see funding go towards larger more impactful initiatives, we are unveiling a new Short North Foundation application process.

### **What Hasn't Changed**

- The priorities: Projects should attempt to meet one or more of the following:
  - Artistic
  - Historical
  - One that brings people together, within the boundaries of the greater Short North
  - Permanent
  - Not programmatic/event-driven
  - Represents the diversity of the Short North
- Additional Funding: Organizations will have or be in the process of securing funding beyond the SNF grant.

### **What Has Changed**

- Grant requests should be for no less than \$10K.
- No application deadline-this is an open call until funds have been expended.
- A higher priority will be placed on neighborhood organization requests with an emphasis on initiatives that serve all.
- Organizations must plan to complete the project within a year of receiving funding unless an extension is approved.
- Organizations must complete a midpoint and final report.

## Process

- Organizations will complete an on-line application which can be saved and edited up until it is submitted.
- If the SNF believes a project should move forward the organization may be invited to an in-person session to respond to questions and provide additional support materials.
- If the SNF approves a project for funding half of the grant funding will be provided at the onset. The second half of the grant will be released upon the successful completion of a mid-way report.
