


Our Transportation Needs Are Growing

Bus Rapid Transit Features

- · Platform-level and multi-door boarding
- Faster, more reliable premium transit
- Operates on 15-minute intervals or less
- Dedicated right-of-way
- Traffic Signal Priority (TSP)
- Modern and branded vehicle designs
- · High frequency and capacity
- Enhanced stations
- Clean energy
- · Quicker construction timeline than light rail
- · One-sixth of the cost of light rail
