- C. Traffic Calming, Infrastructure, and Mobility Jared Cape
 - 1. We have been working with the City and Lime to address parking and sidewalk riding issues. We have been interviewed by the news twice and held an event with Lime to encourage safe riding. This work is ongoing.
 - 2. The Short North Alliance is doing a mobility and placemaking study. We did a walking tour to point out issues along 5th Ave and Neil Ave. We are looking forward to the published results.
